

**WHAT IT IS**

ClauseLine is a specialty-aware physician contract analysis platform. Upload a contract, receive a clause-by-clause analysis with national compensation benchmarks, a red-flag checklist, and a counter-proposal letter. Office Hours chat walks residents through any clause they have questions on.

**WHAT IT COSTS**

**Program License** — \$2,495/yr, unlimited residents

**Code Pack 50** — \$1,500 one-time, 50 redemption codes (entry tier)

**WHY RESIDENTS NEED IT**

- Contract negotiation is not taught in residency curricula — residents enter their first employment negotiation without preparation.
- The first attending contract sets compensation trajectory for a decade or more; initial terms are difficult to renegotiate.
- A \$10/wRVU gap compounds to over \$800,000 in lost lifetime earnings across a 10-year career.

**WHY PROGRAMS BENEFIT**

- Differentiator on the recruitment trail — PGY-4s compare program benefits; contract literacy support is uncommon.
- Demonstrates institutional investment in the transition from training to independent practice.
- Qualifies as a GME-budget-eligible educational tool; no separate committee approval typically required for amounts under \$3,000.

- GME operating budget — PD discretionary; most programs' signature limit covers \$2,495
- Hospital wellness or transition-to-practice budget
